

Dear Mr Mcculloch.

After finding a small lump in his mouth, Jeremy was diagnosed with mouth cancer in 2014. Our Butterfly Team have supported families like the Hunters and their son Jude, who was laid to rest in one of our Butterfly Suites when he passed away at 15 months old. For mum and dad, the Butterfly Team, in their words couldn't have done enough for them.

Mum said:

"All of the hospice staff were so friendly and compassionate. They took away the worry of having to think or organise anything, we could just spend time with Jude knowing everything was taken care of.

The things that seemed small at the time are now so significant. His hand and footprints, made at Claire House, take center place on the fridge and it's so nice to look at them every day. Without the hospice, we wouldn't have that.
