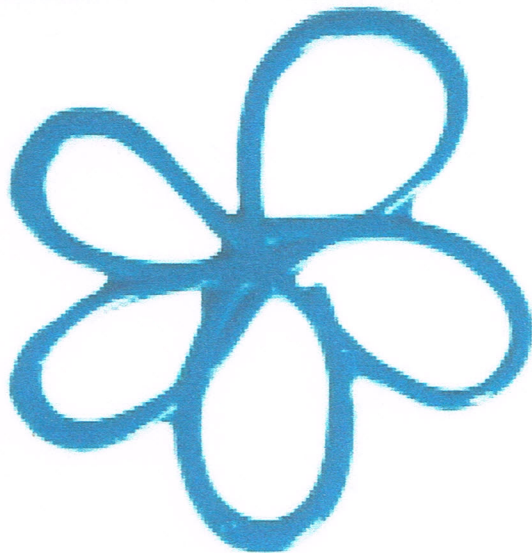

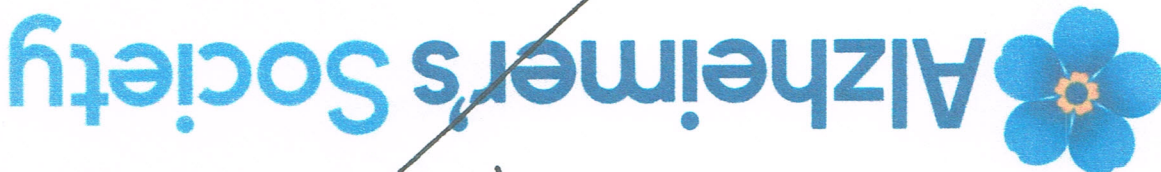

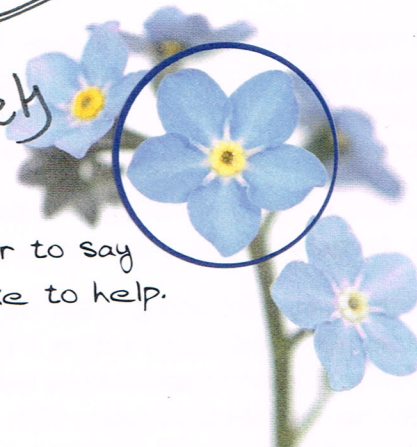

Every day seems to last a lifetime when you're struggling to cope. Your urgent gift could help fund a vital home visit from a Dementia Adviser like

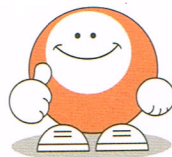

THANK YOU FOR EVERYTHING YOU DO FOR US.



My name is Andy Thomson and I've been a pilot for London's Air Ambulance for over a decade. I'm one of the team responsible for getting our consultants and paramedics to our patients, when time is running out and every second counts. It can be daunting at times, knowing that we are up against time to deliver our medical team to the scene so they can start the life-saving interventions that can be the difference between life and death.

I started flying for our incredible, vital service 11 years ago, just before the 2012 Olympics. There is no doubt in my mind that London is one of the greatest cities in the world. There's that mix of old and new all together in the same space - it's beautiful from the ground but even more incredible when viewed from above.

From that perspective you notice how much the city has changed too. The skyline is constantly evolving: new taller buildings, cranes and drones are just some of the challenges that we now face on a daily basis. It is a very different environment than the one that I first experienced those years ago.

But despite all the changes, some things remain constant. Our patients still need us and we have to continue to be there for London.

NEW HELICOPTERS FOR A CHANGING CITY

In order to do this, we need replace our helicopter fleet by 2024. Our current helicopters, the MD902s, have been great – serving London extremely well for many years, but they are sadly reaching the end of their lifespan. Essential parts needed for their safe operation are becoming more difficult to find and replace, which means that servicing these aircraft is more challenging and more expensive.

SAVING LIVES LONG INTO THE FUTURE

It's so important that as technology changes, we adapt too. That's why, with your help, we are moving to the new Airbus H135 helicopter.

The new helicopters are modern and perfect for flying in a city such as London. Whilst I will be sad to see the current fleet retired, I am looking forward to moving to the next chapter. This will give us the ability to save even more lives in our city, well into the future.

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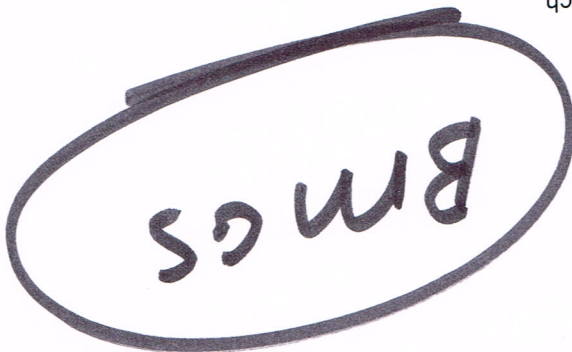

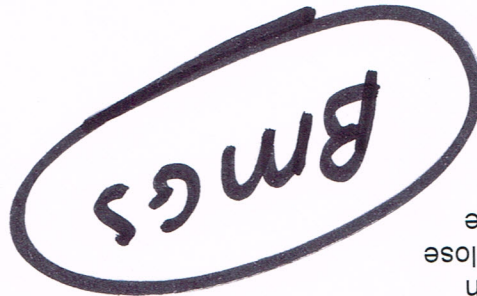
